



Policies and Safety

When you visit Scoop Network and maybe even upload something to us, you join a community of people from all over the world. Every cool, new community feature on Scoop Network involves a certain level of trust. Millions of users respect that trust and we trust you to be responsible too. Following the guidelines below helps to keep Scoop Network fun and enjoyable for everyone.

You might not like everything that you see on Scoop Network. If you think that content is inappropriate, please submit it for review by our staff by sending a mail to info@scoop.network. Our staff carefully reviews flagged content 24 hours a day, 7 days a week to determine whether there's a violation of our Community Guidelines.

Here are some **common-sense rules** that'll help you steer clear of trouble. Please take these rules seriously and take them to heart. Don't try to look for loopholes or try to lawyer your way around the guidelines—just understand them and try to respect the spirit in which they were created.

- Scoop Network is not for sexually explicit content. If this describes your video, even if it's a video of yourself, don't post it on Scoop Network. Also, be advised that we work closely with law enforcement and we report child exploitation.
- Our platform are for entertainment and talent promotion. We don't support content that promotes or condones violence against individuals or groups based on race or ethnic origin, religion, disability, gender, age, nationality, veteran status or sexual orientation/gender identity, or whose primary purpose is inciting hatred on the basis of these core characteristics.
- It's not okay to post abusive videos and comments on Scoop Network. If harassment crosses the line into a malicious attack it can be reported and may be removed. In other cases, users may be mildly annoying or petty and should be ignored.
- It's not okay to post violent or gory content that's primarily intended to be shocking, sensational or gratuitous. If posting graphic content in a news or documentary context, please be mindful to provide enough information to help people understand what's going on in the video. Don't encourage others to commit specific acts of violence.
- Don't post videos that encourage others to do things that might cause them to get badly hurt, especially kids. Videos showing such harmful or dangerous acts may be age-restricted or removed depending on their severity.
- If someone has posted your personal information or uploaded a video of you without your consent, you can request removal of content based on our Privacy Guidelines.
- Respect copyright. Only upload videos that you made or that you're authorised to use. This means don't upload videos that you didn't make, or use content in your videos that someone else owns the copyright to, such as music tracks, snippets of copyrighted programs or videos made by other users, without necessary authorisations.



Permission for film and / or video recordings and broadcasting

The sender of a video or audio file to Scoop Network hereby declares and agrees that he / she unconditionally and irrevocably gives permission to Scoop Network to use the uploaded file in all media including social media, to broadcast, film and/or video recordings of him / her in connection with Scoop Network and or auditions. The undersigned declares that he / she is aware of the fact that he / she might be imaged and broadcasted in a recognizable way, as well as the fact that personal and emotional aspects might be made public. On the part of Scoop Network there is no obligation to actually use the produced material.

Every sender hereby declares to give permission to (re) release the film and / or the video recordings through television and / or Internet, or by any other means, both in and outside all territories. Undersigned or his / her (legal) representative also provides authorization to use the created film and / or video recordings for promotion or in other ways Scoop Network deems necessary.
